When I took a course of Italian before my studies in Rome, one of the students from Lebanon, Ahmad, sang about his love to his girlfriend. He sang in Arabic. Thus we couldn't understand it, but in his voice, in the melody there was so much nostalgia that you could feel it in your heart. It was simply beautiful, but when he translated the words into Italian, we all remained astonished. He sang: "When you, my love, are far away from me, I miss you so much that I lose my senses, but when you are in my arms I feel nothing but boredom and annoyance." How come? - We kept asking. How come?

When we read today's first reading, we can sense in the words of the ancient prophet Jeremiah similar longing. When he writes these words, his people are far away from their country, driven by force away from their motherland. From afar the ancient promise of a future Saviour sounds more powerful and the desire to see him grows high. But when the Messiah finally came, instead of a shout of joy, he heard: "Crucify him!" And again we all astonished can ask: "How come?"

When we read today's second reading with attention, we can almost feel in our soul the love that Saint Paul had for Jesus, his Lord. He cares so much that the community, which he founded in Thessalonica, be ready for the second coming of Jesus, that he almost lacks words to express it. And yet — when we look at nowadays Christians, what can we see? They with all excitement and care, go to supermarkets to buy appropriate presents for their beloved ones for Christmas; with detailed attention they prepare their houses for Holidays: Christmas tree, ornaments, lights inside and outside their houses, snowmen, Santa with reindeers and the sledge; they carefully choose their menu for Christmas Vigil and dinner. But when finally this expected moment of Christmas comes, they feel not so much joy as much tiredness, fatigue and weariness. And we all astonished can ask: how come?

Did really Ahmad expect his beloved girl, desiring to meet her or rather concentrated on his own feelings overlooked the beauty of his girlfriend's love?

Did really Israelites expect the God's messenger who would teach them the ways of God? Or rather concentrating on their difficult situation wanted someone with supernatural power to fix their problem?

Do really nowadays Christians expect the second coming of Jesus, trying to prepare their hearts by living in a way pleasing to God? Or rather concentrating on themselves, they walk through their lives with eyes directed down to earth, not even noticing any other perspective?

Dear Brother, dear Sister,

It doesn't need to be this way. Today we begin Advent. You don't have to run! Rather – stop for a moment, gain your freedom! Kneel down in your house along with your wife and children and pray together for a while, read the Bible stories about Christmas! Maybe this time at Christmas you will be astonished, when you will see your family united around the Christmas tree and talking with eagerness about Jesus... and again you will ask yourself: How come?
