Let us pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys fraught with danger and violence, may find welcome and new living opportunities in their host countries.







three Today's incidents readings present reflection. 1) Adam who hid himself from God after he sinned, because he was naked. 2) Jesus who said that all sins can be forgiven except the sin against the Holy Spirit. 3) And the mother and the brothers and sisters of the Lord who think that Jesus has gone mad. The first incident reveals the tragic consequence of sin in human life - we perceive God not as a friend but as a threat, a danger to our existence, we feel 'naked', defenceless in from of God. The second incident

points to the fact that our sins can't be forgiven if we don't believe that God can forgive our sins, which is the sin against the Holy Spirit. Our trusting faith in God is of outmost importance -God will take care of our 'nakedness' in a loving way. The third incident shows that the closest



family (his cousins) was not helping Jesus in fulfilling his mission, because they were following human way of thinking rather than following God's will. The true family of Jesus are those who do the will of his Father. Do you hide from God like Adam or do you entrust to God your 'nakedness' - your frailty, brokenness, vulnerability, trusting in his love for you?
