Today's readings align with the flourishing of nature in the late spring with many images taken from the flora.

Prophet Ezekiel in the first reading uses the image of cedar, a giant tree reaching 20 meters of height. God can break a branch from the top of it, plant it and make it into a great tree. The prophet is referring to the great empire of Babylon, where the Israelites are in exile like a little branch in a big tree. They can be planted again in their homeland and become a great nation. It is an image of hope for the exiles.



In the Gospel Jesus uses two images taken from nature. The first describes the grain of wheat that once sown into the ground by a farmer it grows by itself without his knowledge. It shows the power of God's action in our lives. God acts even when we don't realize it. And yet – our cooperation is necessary, however minimal it might seem: the farmer needs to sow the grain and do the harvesting. The image of a mustard tree that grows from a little grain and becomes a great tree, a shelter for many birds, illustrates the dynamism of the Kingdom of God, which seems small at the beginning but then becomes a great home for all the nations of the world.

Do we allow the Kingdom of God to grow in our lives?

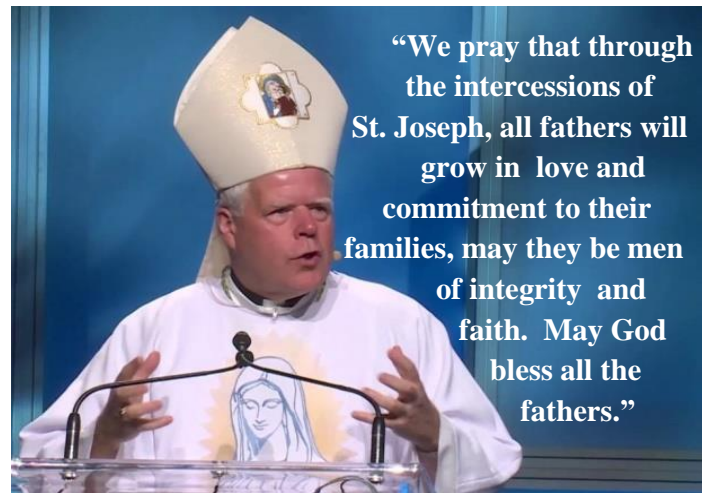
