Dear Family in Christ,

Peace be with you, and a blessed Second Sunday of Advent to you and your families. This Sunday, the Church turns our attention to the Peace of Christ- a peace many of us might find difficult to come by this time of year.

St. Augustine offers a profound reflection on peace. When things are so arranged that justice is done to each and each can work toward the good according to capability, the harmony that arises can properly be called 'Peace': "The peace of the celestial city is the perfectly ordered and harmonious enjoyment of God, and of one another in God. The peace of all things is the tranquility of order. Order is the distribution which allots things equal and unequal, each to its own place" ("City of God," Bk. 19 Ch. 13). What does this peace look like for us today?


Today, many of us make the mistake of believing that peace is 'just around the corner'- once I get through x or y, once I get the promotion, get married, retire, move houses, start school, finish exams, etc., then I will finally have peace. If you've been alive for long enough, you have probably found that this is not often the case. There is almost always another corner to turn, another milestone to wait(or work) for, and the kind of peace we seek is just as far away as when we began.

Perhaps the peace we seek is not so much the absence of danger, difficulties, anxieties, problems, or distress, but the presence of God amidst all of that. It is found not so much in overcoming the obstacles of life, but in facing them with Godin the Faith and Hope that reminds me who I am, to whom I belong, and most importantly, who He is, and seeing whatever circumstances I find myself in light of that. It's amazing what we can face, what we can endure and overcome when we know, believe, and live according to the truth that 'Greater is He who is in me, than he who is in the world.' (1 John 4:4)

On this Second Sunday of Advent, listen for every time we mention, pray for, and wish one another 'Peace' during the Mass. May peace not merely be a word we say, but a gift we receive and share.

"Peace, I leave you- My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid." (John 14:27)
